1. Call meeting to order at 0607 pm.
2. Old business:

 2. Bridge installed at the Mifflin Gap Jump- no longer a gap.
 3. Black Rock Down added to lower Geronimo.
 4. New Signs were installed on Mahalas and Rogue Troll trails. Fireman Climb, To the Top, Madcow, Jaws, Grizzly Jump line signs all need installed.
 5. TMTA Trail Bell box with QR Code is ready to be installed!
4. Financials
